

Community Book Bank Report 2019-20

As per the directives of DCE Rajasthan Jaipur letter no. CCE/P&C/ISDC/CBB/2019/18 Dated: 07-09-2019 a Community Book Bank Programme was started for college students at Government Meera Girls College Udaipur. For this a community Book bank was established in college library campus. Books are being obtained from senior, retired faculty members as well as donors from society. For conducting Community Book Bank in a systematic manner a committee has been formed comprising of

1. DrSaroj Gupta, Coordinator
2. Dr Monika Dave, Co coordinator Arts faculty
3. Dr Monika Dungarwal, Co coordinator Arts faculty
4. DrBinduKataria, Co coordinator Science faculty
5. DrInduArora, Co coordinator Commerce faculty

15 college student volunteers have been included in this committee and every coordinator has been assigned student volunteers in proportion to the number of students in that faculty. The time duration of nominated student volunteers shall be one year or maximum of the two years.

A training program for faculty members and volunteer college student members was held on. 24th January 2020 in which they all were given intensive training by library assistant ShriJayeshPurohit related to technical process of entry, issue and deposit of books in the library.

From time to time information related to donating of books by college faculty members and ex students was given on notice boards, student hostels and college porch. Alumnae faculty members and friends were asked to donate books through electronic media. To obtain books from donation the names and mobile number of coordinator /co coordinator and volunteer students were displayed on notice boards. The regular students can get books issued on priority basis for a maximum of three months or till exams on priority basis.

Following students can get benefit from the said Book bank

- aregular student of the college.
- BPL and economically weaker students.
- all students studying in college
- students obtaining merit in Boards/University are being given priority.

The principle of first come first serve is being followed subject to the availability of donated books to students.

Books which can be donated are-

1. Books which are in good condition and not torn.
2. Books related to regular syllabus should not be more than 3 years old .
3. Literature related books can be donated.
4. Current affairs books should not be older than 1 year and general knowledge book shall not be older than 2 years.

The arrangement for issuing and depositing shall be as follows

1. Before the books are issued to the students, applications are invited from the college students.
2. On the basis of student applications the available books are issued to students on First Come First basis.
3. A facility of issuing books on clubbing and sharing basis is provided to students which means a group of 2 - 3 students together will be issued one book each which they can share and study among themselves.

In this manner maximum number of students can be benefited.

The record of applicants and students who have received books from Community Book Bank is being maintained in the college library and some of respective departments.

The rules have also been framed for returning books in the college.

Proactive voluntary cooperation in Community Book Bank of faculty members is taken for the benefit of the students. Complete transparency is maintained regarding administration, management and publicity of the plan. Publicity of this program is done on a regular basis, so that maximum number of students benefit from it. This is a positive intervention for societal development. In this way we can build a healthy happy and concerned attitude among the students in higher education.

For this the community Book bank Inauguration was done by respected Principal Dr Nidhi Srivastava at library of Government Meera Girls College Udaipur.

Till now there are 386 donated books in the Community Book Bank in the academic year 2019-20.
