### **IQAC Action Taken Report**

#### **Session- 2018-19**

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college worked towards the quality enhancement of the college throughout the year. In the beginning of the session, a number of proposals were given to different committees of the college such as: In August 2018, IQAC verified documents and calculated API scores (CAS applications) of 11 qualifying candidates for Pay Band- IV. Our College was Nodal college, so IQAC evaluated applications of candidates of other colleges as well. In September 2018, on the proposal of IQAC, Department of Zoology introduced a new teaching pedagogy- Jigsaw Method by taking PG Zoology students as model.

In February 2019, Feedback was taken from Students, Alumni and Parents which was analyzed and submitted to the Principal for perusal and necessary action.

In November 2018, faculty profile format for session 2017-18 was prepared and distributed to the Faculty Members in order to prepare AQAR for session 2017-18



### **Meeting with In-Charges and Committee Convenors**

In December 2018, IQAC Organised a meeting with In Charge of Departments and Committee convenors to keep them abreast with Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC for Cycle III Accreditation. Principal Dr Ritu Matharu and IQAC Coordinator Dr Shashi Sanchiher addressed the meeting. Departmental Profile Formats were given to In charge of departments and Committee Report formats were given to committee convenors to prepare report of last 5 years , a step in direction of Cycle III Accreditation process.



**Lecture on “Organisational Behaviour and Stress Management”**

IQAC organised an extension Lecture in January 2019 for Ministerial and Subordinate staff on “ Organisational Behaviour and Stress management” in which Dr Ira Bhatnagar , Associate Professor Economics and Assisstant Director, OTS delivered lecture on the topic. The participants were benefitted by this as they learned how to manage stress at the work place.

A solid waste management facility was developed in the college through vermicomposting and vermicompost harvested through this facility is to be utilized in the gardens and plantations of the college.
