#### **Activities and Events:**

#### 1. Educational Field Visit:

Students from both the previous and final years of the postgraduate program studied the biodiversity of Sajjan Niwas Garden, Udaipur (Gulab Bagh) on 21.07.2023. They observed various types of plants including algae, fungi, bryophytes, pteridophytes, and angiosperms. They also examined 300-year-old Mahogany trees and collected samples of several plants such as Kanak Champa, Katili Champa, Golden Champa, Tuna ciliata, Aakash Neem, Sterculia foetida, Kalpavriksha, Tamarix, etc. They also observed ferns like Fish Tail Palm, Bottle Palm, Nephrolepis, and others. The students also visited the Bird Park and learned about different species of birds.





## 2. Central Laboratory Visit:

On 26.07.2023, students from the final year of the postgraduate program visited the central laboratory of the Botany Department at Mohanlal Sukhadia University, under the guidance of Dr. Kiran Tak and Dr. Vartika Jain. They learned about the functionality and utility of various scientific instruments, including Gas Chromatography, Mass Spectrometry, UV-Visible

Spectrophotometer, HPLC, Thermo Cycler, Fluorescence Microscope, Gel-Electrophoresis, and Refrigerated Centrifuge Machine. They conducted observed practical applications of some of these instruments.





#### 3. National Seminar:

A National seminar on **Plant Taxonomy and Nomenclature** was organized under the joint aegis of the Postgraduate Council, IQAC, and Indian Botanical Society, Udaipur Chapter (IBS-UC) on 10.08.2023. The keynote speaker, Prof. Surendra Singh from Choudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut, explained the techniques for drying plant specimens and storing them on herbarium sheets. He also provided an easy guide for plant identification. The second speaker, Prof. Farhat Banu (Retired Assistant Director, College Education, Udaipur), discussed the types of forests in Rajasthan and the plants found therein through a PPT presentation. Principal Dr. Meena Baya emphasized the significance of the seminar, and IQAC Coordinator Prof. Anjana Gautam highlighted the importance of such seminars in understanding the value of plants, especially in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. IBS-Udaipur Chapter President Dr. Vineet Soni discussed the utility of the seminar in accurate plant identification.









#### 4. Eco-friendly Rakhi Making Competition:

A competition was organized on 04.09.2023 where students were asked to make Rakhi using parts of plants and their various components. The students created beautiful and interesting Rakhis using plant parts such as seeds, leaves, twigs and various types of flowers. The judges for the competition were Dr. Savita Chahar, Head of the Botany Department, Dr. Nasreen Banu, and Dr. Ameesh Dev Singh. The winners were from the PG final year, Riddhi Goyal (First), Siddhi Choubisa (Second), and Dharmistha Vyas (Third) from the final PG final year.
